
For Immediate Action | Stop Work Under all HUD Funded TA Agreements per OMB-M-25-13

HUD TA Providers and Partners,

Effective at 5:00pm, please stop work immediately for ALL activities under all three HUD funded TA programs: Community Compass, Thriving Communities and Distressed Cities to ensure compliance with OMB Memo M-25-13 which calls for the temporary pause of agency grant, loan, and federal financial assistance programs. We are not requiring you to take any action in DRGR at this time- just halt all activity under HUD funded TA. Do not edit, amend, or submit new work plans unless an exception is granted by the Cooperative Agreement Officer.

Under this new directive, HUD is pausing reimbursement for existing vouchers while the Agency undertakes a comprehensive review. Once we are authorized to resume TA, we will notify you via email. If you have not yet submitted your Quarterly Performance Reports by 5:00pm today, please hold them until we resume TA award activities and we will issue a new due date at that time.

If you have trainings, grantee-facing engagements, or travel, please cancel immediately and notify grantees of the pause. We recommend sample language you may leverage below:

“As a HUD-funded TA provider, our firm has been advise that we need to pause TA delivery activity to ensure compliance with OMB Memo M-25-13 calling for temporary pause of agency grant, loan, and federal financial assistance programs until further notice. Once we are authorized to resume the technical assistance programs, we will reach out to engage with you again. We are sorry for the inconvenience and sincerely look forward to working with you again and hopefully soon.”

We appreciate the efforts to comply with recent directives and commit to keeping you updated via email. We appreciate the partnership and all you have done and will continue to do to support capacity building for HUD customers and communities.
